8. In what ways is Christ's humility described in Phil. 2:5-11?

9. How do you think your closest relationships might change if you faithfully followed Jesus' example in Phil. 2:5-8 for a year?

10. What would it look like for someone to change from being a "grasper" to a "giver?"

11. What keeps many Christians from really following Jesus' example of servanthood as described in Phil. 2:5-8?

12. If you were asked to give a seminar on leadership as modeled by Jesus in Phil. 2:5-8, how would your seminar likely differ from a typical secular/worldly viewpoint?

13. Read Isaiah 53, and describe the leadership principles of Jesus as contained in this passage.

14. What does it mean that Jesus "emptied himself" in Phil. 2:7? How does Paul explain this in Phil. 2:7-8?

 \rightarrow Why is understanding this concept vitally important to our doctrine about Jesus?

15. Read Matthew 17:1-8 and Luke 9:31-32. How might this event help us better understand the incarnation of Jesus?
